What is a PENNY WAR ????

A Penny War is a fundraising competition in which several teams collect coins and bills in an effort to raise money or points based on the amounts and the denominations collected.

All ASA students will be assigned to a specific color team. Each team will have a bucket for collecting money. Typically, groups collect coins, but dollar bills may also be included. The value of pennies collected by each team count toward the team's point total. The value of other coins and dollar bills are then subtracted from the total penny amount.

Teams get ahead by adding lots of pennies into their own buckets. Teams work against each other by contributing nickels, dimes, quarters and dollars into their competitors buckets.

At the end of the week, the winning team is declared by having the highest number of pennies/points collected.

All of the money collected will go to the Parsippany Animal Shelter! Those special pets will be the big winners!
